



The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) Summary Report indicates that you have a Pell Grant overpayment that was paid to you from a school you previously attended. IMPORTANT: If you have a grant overpayment, you are **NOT** eligible for federal, state, or institutional financial aid until you provide documentation from that previous school or the Department of Education showing that your overpayment status has been cleared.

Please provide a **CURRENT** letter from either the school where the overpayment occurred or from the Department of Education stating that the overpayment has been paid.

If you believe this information to be in error, please provide our office with documentation that indicates you are not in an overpayment status.
